

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Henry C. Conrad, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Powder Wash

through creek and reservoir for stock watering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Sec. 17, T.17N, R. 53E, M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SE corner of Sec. 7, T. 16N, R. 53E, M.D.B. & M., bears S. 3° 15' 30" W. a distance of 28,353 feet. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Eureka Ranch Co.
Post-office address Eureka, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.003906 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 125 cattle.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 29, 1968

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from Powder Wash and thence conveyed to a reservoir located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 125 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
