WHEREAS Henry C. Conrad, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 2, T. 17N., R. 53E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Sec. 6, T. 17N., R. 54E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 79° 50' E. a distance of 13,345 feet

situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.00703 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 225 head of cattle.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 29, 1968

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed from Ratto Canyon and thence conveyed to a reservoir located within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 2, T. 17N., R. 53E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used to water 225 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
