The geologic surveys were performed independently of one another and were non-repetitive of any other surveys. Surveys were directed toward the economic evaluation of mineral potential of the subject claims based upon environment of existing gold deposits in the district, comprehensive on-the-ground field examination and evaluation of work completed to date.

Basic findings of the surveys show that the claims group is underlain by geology similar to that underlying the existing producing properties in the district and is thus favorable for deposition of economic deposits of precious metals, particularly gold. In each instance an exploration-development program was recommended encompassing further geological, geochemical and geophysical work, to be followed by drilling, assaying and feasibility mining and heap leaching tests by volume sampling and metallurgical recovery programs.

Said work was performed and improvements made at the request of East Utah Mining Company, the owner, and had a value in excess of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for each claim.


The undersigned is the President and General Manager of said East Utah Mining Company and is the person who directed the performance of such labor and improvements.
