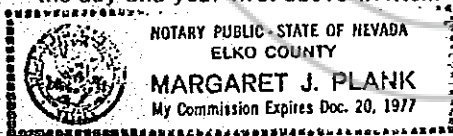
Block 2 Lot 27, Crescent Valley Ranch and Farms
