To all to whom these presents shall come, GREETING:

WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Reno, Nevada, has been deposited in the General Land Office, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress of May 30, 1908, "To secure forestland to public domain of the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of John Hickison, Assignee, involving the right of Joseph W. Lemon, has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section thirty in Township twenty-one north and the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section twenty-one in Township twenty-two north all in Range forty-eight east of the Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada, containing ninety acres, according to the official Plat of the survey of the said land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor-General:

NOW KNOW YE, that there is, this day, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said claimant the tract of Land above is class:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimant forever, subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, Warren G. Harding, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

GIVEN under my hand, in the District of Columbia, the Third day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and forty-sixth.
