TOWNSHIP 30 NORTH, RANGE 48 EAST, M.D.B. & M.

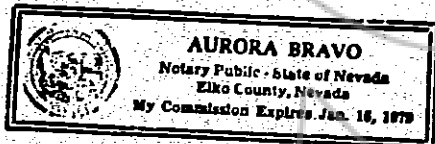
Section 17: NE 1/4 NW 1/4
