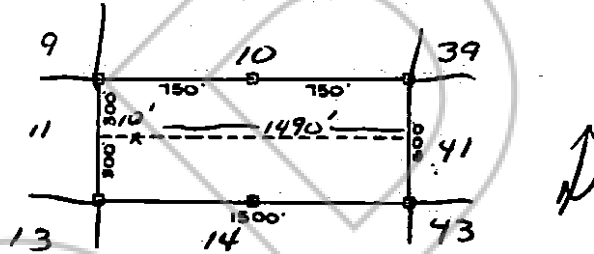

This claim is 1500 feet long and 600 feet wide with the discovery being in the center of the claim 10' feet E. of the E. End Center. The general course of this claim is E.-W.
