The northwest corner is marked by a 4"x4" POST 4 feet high, inscribed "NW Corner

 high, inscribed "SW Corner of the NEE 179 Claim;" the southeast corner is marked by
 a 4"x4" POST 4 feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the NEE 179 Claim;" the
 northeast corner is marked by a 4"x4" POST 4 feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the
NEE 179 Claim." There is also a 4"x4" POST 4 at the center of each side line.

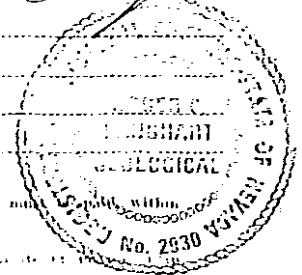
The monumentation and marking of the corners was completed by the 18TH day of JUNE, 1976.
