 northeast corner is marked by a 4"x4" Post 4 feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the
NEE 217 Claim." There is also a 4"x4" Post at the center of each side line.

The monumentation and marking of the corners was completed by the 21TH day of JUNE, 1976.
 (must be within 30 days of posting notice of location)

 claim map have been filed with the EUREKA County Recorder, and the \$15.00 lode claim
 filing fee has been paid to the County Recorder.
