We (or I) claim 1470 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge, ledge or vein, extending 1480 feet from the location monument in a EAST direction, and 20 feet in a WEST direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The northwest corner is marked by a 4" Pipe 4 feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the NEE 220 Claim;" the southwest corner is marked by a 4"x4" Post 4 feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the NEE 220 Claim;" the southeast corner is marked by a 4"x4" Post 4 feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the NEE 220 Claim;" the northeast corner is marked by a 4" Pipe 4 feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the NEE 220 Claim." There is also a 4" Pipe or 4"x4" Post at the center of each side line.

The monumentation and marking of the corners was completed by the 2nd day of July, 1976.
