on the 30th day of June, 1976, situated in the CENTER Mining District, EUREKA County, State of NEVADA, in Section 3, Township 26N, Range 48E.


We (or I) claim 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 26 feet from the location monument in a EASTERN direction, and 1486 feet in a WESTERN direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The northwest corner is marked by a 4" PIPE 4 feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the NCE 227 Claim;" the southwest corner is marked by a 4" PIPE 4 feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the NCE 227 Claim;" the southeast corner is marked by a 4" PIPE 4 feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the NCE 227 Claim;" the northeast corner is marked by a 4" PIPE 4 feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the NCE 227 Claim." There is also a 4" PIPE 4 at the center of each side line.

The monumentation and marking of the corners was completed by the 10th day of July, 1976.
(must be within 10 days of posting Notice of Location)

The location work consisted of making a claim map as provided in NRS 517.040. Two copies of this claim map have been filed with the EUREKA County Recorder, and the \$15.00 lode claim filing fee has been paid to the County Recorder.
