THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the NEE 243 lode mining claim

CORTEZ Mining District, EUREKA County, State of
NEVADA, in Section 32, Township 26N, Range 48E.

We (or I) claim 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge, lode or
vein, extending 20 feet from the location monument in a EASTERN direction,
and 1480 feet in a WESTERN direction, together with 300 feet on
each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The northwest corner is marked by a 4" x 4" Post 4 feet high, inscribed "NW Corner
of the NEE 243 Claim;" the southwest corner is marked by a 4" PIPE 4 feet
high, inscribed "SW Corner of the NEE 243 Claim;" the southeast corner is marked by
a 4" PIPE 4 feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the NEE 243 Claim;" the
northeast corner is marked by a 4" x 4" Post 4 feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the
NEE 243 Claim." There is also a 4" pipe 4" x 4" Post at the center of each side line.

The monumentation and marking of the corners was completed by the 6TH day of JULY, 1976.
(must be within 90 days of posting notice of location)


The location work consisted of making a claim map as provided in NRS 517.040. Two copies of this
