## CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the NEE 244 lode mining claim was located by:

on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of JULY, 1976, situated in the CORTEZ Mining District, EUREKA County, State of NEVADA, in Section 32, Township 26 N, Range 48 E.

We (or I) claim 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 26 feet from the location monument in a EASTERN direction, and 1486 feet in a WESTERN direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The northwest corner is marked by a 4" PIPE 4 feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the NEE 244 Claim;" the southwest corner is marked by a 4" PIPE 4 feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the NEE 244 Claim;" the southeast corner is marked by a 4"x4" POST 4 feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the NEE 244 Claim;" the northeast corner is marked by a 4"x4" POST 4 feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the NEE 244 Claim." There is also a 4"x4" POST at the center of each side line.

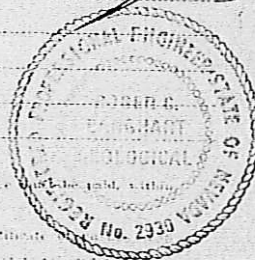
The monumentation and marking of the corners was completed by the 8<sup>th</sup> day of JULY, 1976.  
(must be within 30 days of posting notice of location)

The location work consisted of making a claim map as provided in NRS 517.040. Two copies of this claim map have been filed with the EUREKA County Recorder, and the \$15.00 lode claim filing fee has been paid to the County Recorder.

Note 1: Two copies of this certificate and two copies of the claim map must be filed, and the \$15 filing fee must be paid, within 30 days after the date of posting Notice of Location.

Note 2: "Every person who willfully and knowingly makes a false material statement on the location certificate required by this chapter shall be guilty of a felony, and upon conviction thereof shall be sentenced to pay the principal term of 2 years, not more than 18 months, with 12 months suspended."

Note 3: This certificate is subject to the provisions of the Nevada Mining Act.
