We (or I) claim 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 25 feet from the location monument in a EASTERN direction, and 1475 feet in a WESTERN direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The northwest corner is marked by a 4" PIPE 4 feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the NEE 250 Claim;" the southwest corner is marked by a 4" X 4" POST 4 feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the NEE 250 Claim;" the southeast corner is marked by a 4" PIPE 4 feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the NEE 250 Claim;" the northeast corner is marked by a 4" PIPE 4 feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the NEE 250 Claim." There is also a 4" PIPE OR 4" X 4" POST at the center of each side line.

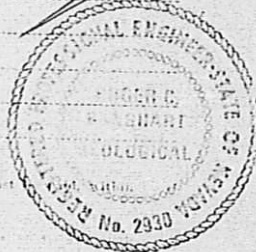
The monumentation and marking of the corners was completed by the 16TH day of JULY, 1976.
