

That said labor was performed during the period between September 1, 1976 and September 1, 1977.



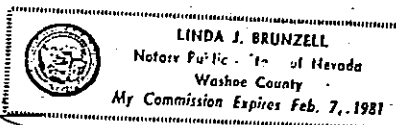
That such work was done and performed for the benefit of each and all of the unpatented lode mining claims, all being contiguous.
