Will the projected income on this property be \$2,500 or more? Yes, maybe.
If yes, describe the projected operation and include projected income calculation. Because of delays, the land was not seeded for production until late summer. There is enough feed on it now that, should it be necessary to cut right away, an income of over \$2,500 could be realized. However, if the weather remains good, an income of considerably more could be realized.
