

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF LODE MINING CLAIM

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The undersigned hereby certifies that he has located the Black Sheep 32 lode mining claim in the NW quarter of Section 22 Township 23 North, Range 48 East, and the SW quarter of Section 22 Township 23 North, Range 48 East, of the Mount Diablo Meridian, in an unorganized mining district, of Eureka County, in the State of Nevada, on the 30th day of June, 1978, for NL Industries, Inc., 5926 McIntyre, Golden, Colorado 80401.

The claim is 1500 feet long and 600 feet wide and 20 feet is claimed in a S9°13'W direction along the length of the claim and 1480 feet is claimed in N9°13'E direction along the length of the claim from the Location Monument at which the Notice of Location is posted, together with 300 feet in width on each side of the center of the claim. The general course of the lode deposit, as can be determined at this time, is in a Northerly and Southerly direction.

The location of each corner of the claim is shown on the claim map that is filed herewith. On the ground each corner, side corner, or location monument is marked with its appropriate designation on an aluminum tag nailed securely to a 4 inch by 4 inch wooden post, 4-1/2 feet in length, substantially erected at each corner, side corner, location point, or witness corner.

The monumentation and marking of the above mentioned corners on the ground was completed on the 12th day of July, 1978 and the location work consisted of making a claim map as provided in NRS 517.040. Two copies of this claim map are filed with the Eureka County Recorder, and the \$15.00 lode claim filing fee has been paid to the County Recorder.
