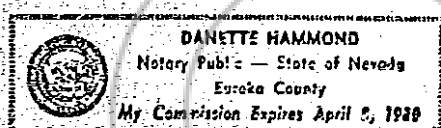

REPORT OF BASIC FINDINGS OF GEOCHEMICAL SURVEY

The writer is familiar with the claims owned by Charles Damele, Sr., et.al., known as the Curlew #1-#20, Show Cap #2-#4, Cedar, Damele #1-#9, Mtn. View, Rain Cap, Rocky, Sunday, Sunset, Zero #1-#6, Big Ben, Cedar, Dales Boner, D-2, Irishman, Marie, Miss Carriage, Pollywog, Wetherford and Dale Claims.

During August, 1978, the writer supervised a geochemical survey on these claims. The sampling program consisted of taking soil and rock samples from the claims on a grid pattern. The samples were then analyzed for their gold content. The values for gold ranged from .02 ppm to .24 ppm. There appeared to be anomalous concentrations in certain areas. These may be related to the thrust faulting exposed at numerous places on the claims, and the higher values occur in the lower plate rocks.

It is recommended that the samples taken be run for their arsenic and mercury content and the results correlated with the gold values, and that additional samples be taken to further delineate the anomalous areas.
