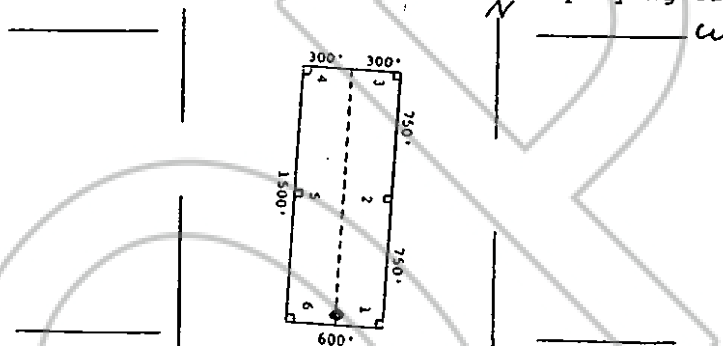


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the SEL RAT No. 76 lode mining claim has been located by AMSELCO MINERALS INC., a Delaware corporation, whose address is 1000 Bible Way, Suite 66, Reno, Nevada 89502. The general course of this claim is North 3 West. This claim is 1500 feet in length along the course of the claim, being 1490 feet from the point of discovery in a N3 W direction to the North end line of this claim, and 10 feet in a S3 E direction to the South end line of the claim. This claim is 600 feet in width, being 300 feet in width on each side of the center line of the claim.

This claim is located within the NW Quarter of Section 27, Township 18 North, Range 53 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, Eureka Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada. The location monument of this claim is situated with reference to some natural object or permanent monument as follows: Corner No. 1 is located appx.: 4100 feet N 30° W of claim location marker SR1

The claim location marker SR1, a 3"x6" steel pipe, is located appx.: 1.93 mi N76°E from Gray's Peak; 2.50 mi N8°E from South Hill Peak; 0.55 mi S27°W from Surprise Peak.

The corners of this claim are marked by 4"x4" posts or 4" trees with metal tags inscribed with the appropriate corner number as shown on the following sketch and the accompanying claim map.
