Notice is hereby given that the undersigned hereby locates and claims the following described piece of mineral bearing ground as a lode mining claim. From this discovery monument 20 feet in a S30°E direction, then 300° feet in a N30°W direction to the SE end monument, then 750 feet in a N30°W direction to the NE side center monument, then 750 feet in the same direction to the NE end monument, then 600° feet in a S60°W direction to the NW end monument, then 750 feet in a S30°E direction to the SW side center, then 750 feet in the same direction to the SW side center, then 600° feet in the same direction to the SW end monument, and then 600 feet in a N60°E direction to return to the SE end monument.
