

## LOCATION CERTIFICATE----LODE CLAIM

The undersigned citizen of the United States, Gary L. Grauberger, hereby declares that on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of MARCH, 1980, he discovered and located the DC-11 lode bearing mining claim.

The claim is situated in the ANTELOPE mining district, EUREKA County, Nevada, in the NE quarter of Section 19, Township 24N, Range 51E, Mount Diablo Meridian. The claim is 600 feet wide and 1500 feet long. The general course of the claim is EAST and WEST and the locator claims 20 feet in a WEST direction and 1480 feet in a EAST direction from the discovery monument, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the lode.

The detailed location of each corner is shown on the required map filed with this location certificate. Each of the four corners is marked by a 4" x 4" wooden post, or a 4" diameter PVC pipe or a topped and blazed tree, inscribed with the name of the claim and appropriate number of the corner on metal tags.

The location work consisted of making the maps as provided in NRS 517.040.
