This detailed report is filed in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code Section 28-1 for the Belmont-Lead Bar group of 21 contiguous unpatented mining claims, N MC-120700 thru N MC-120720, situated in the Antelope Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada.

The work consisted of geologic mapping and geochemical sampling of the entire claim group and adjacent area. The work was done to evaluate the potential for valuable mineral deposits and assist in further exploration and development work.

The work was performed by David C. Jonson of 1530 Alkire Street, Golden, Colorado 80401, a geologist with his MS Degree from the Colorado School of Mines, Golden, Colorado and 25 years experience in the mining exploration industry.

Mineralized and altered zones occur in the Ordovician Vinini formation and in fault zones in the Devonian Devils Gate formation. The Vinini formation has been thrust over the underlying Devils Gate formation and a few highly altered intrusive dikes were noted. Initial geochemical results indicate that the altered rocks in both the Vinini formation and Devils Gate formation are anomalous in As, Au, Ag, Sb and Pb.
