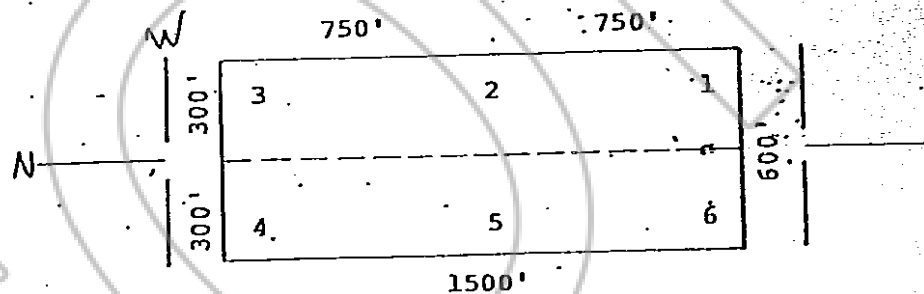


NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that St. Pat No. 182 lode mining claim has been located by American Selco, a New York corporation, whose address 90 West Grove Street, Suite 100, Reno, Nevada 89509. This claim is a relocation of the St. Pat No. 182 lode mining claim, the certificate of location of which is of record in the office of the Recorder of Eureka County, Nevada in Book 88 Page 471, in accordance with NRS 517.080. The general course of this claim is North/South. This claim is 1500 feet in length along the course of the claim, being 1490 feet from the point of discovery in an North direction to the North end line of this claim, and 10 feet in a South direction to the South end line of the claim. This claim is 600 feet in width, being 300 feet in width on each side of the center line of the claim.

This claim is located within the SE Quarter of Section 4, Township 17 North, Range 52 East, Mount Diablo Base & Meridian, Eureka Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada. The location monument of this claim is situated with reference to some natural object or permanent monument as follows: The number one corner of this claim is located approximately 12,600 feet S 62° W from the SE corner of section 36, T18N, R52E, MDM.

The corners of this claim are marked by 4" x 4" x 5' posts or pipe with metal tags inscribed with the appropriate corner number as shown on the following sketch and the accompanying claim map.
