TITLE: REPORT ON A GEOCHEMICAL SURVEY CONDUCTED ON THE LYNDALL 1
THRU 91 LOSE CLAIMS FOR THE 1980-81 ASSESSMENT PERIOD.

This report is in compliance with the Bureau of Land Management Circular No. 2289, "Regulations Pertaining to Mining Claims Under the General Mining Laws of 1872." (As contained in Title 43 of the Code of Federal Regulations.) Subpart 5 3851.2, Inclusion of Surveys in Assessment Work.

The Lyndall claims numbers 1 thru 91, are located on the western slope of the Roberts Mountains in Sections 15, 16, 17, 21, 22, 27 and 28, in T. 23 N., R. 50 E. M. D. B & M in Eureka County, Nevada.

Geochemical surveys were undertaken on the ground for mineral deposits during August 1981. These surveys included the collection and preparation of geologic samples, (predominantly soil samples). (Soil samples were generally collected at a depth of 4 to 6 inches.) These samples were analyzed for precious metals and known indicators. The preparation of these samples for analysis included drying, crushing, grinding, and sifting to minus 80 mesh. Then the samples were analyzed. Samples have been analyzed by All Minerals Corporation Laboratory.

The cost of the work performed on these 83 claims amounted to more than \$8,300.00 dollars. The work covered the entire area on these 83 claims. Also, some of the area adjacent to these claims was included.

The basic findings of the geochemical survey have not been completed at this time. We are in the process of evaluating all of the data, chemical reports, geochemical maps, lab analyses, etc.
