28 STIPULATION AND ORDER

29 Plaintiffs, through their counsel, having moved
30 for an order restraining Defendant GENE D. CLAYTON ("Clayton")
31 for the duration of this litigation from selling, transferring,
32 assigning, liquidating or otherwise disposing of or concealing
any property owned by him with a value in excess of \$500.00,
and Defendant Clayton, through his counsel, having been
served with the moving papers and being willing to stipulate,

1 with certain limited exceptions noted below, to the entry of
2 such an order during the pendency of this litigation.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, the Plaintiffs and Defendant
4 Clayton, through their respective counsel, hereby stipulate
5 and agree, and the Court, having been fully advised of the
6 premises, hereby orders that:

7 1. Pending the final adjudication of the merits of
8 this law suit and pending further order of this Court,
9 Defendant Clayton shall not sell, transfer, assign, liquidate,
10 pledge, hypothecate, alienate, or otherwise dispose of or
11 conceal any property of any kind or description, wherever
12 located, with a value of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or
13 more. As used in this Stipulation and Order, the term
14 "property" includes, but is not limited to, Clayton's interest
15 in and/or title to real estate, stocks, bonds, other securities,
16 vehicles, farm or other heavy equipment, and bank accounts,
17 wherever located.

18 2. Defendant Clayton shall make no agreements for
19 the sale, transfer, assignment, pledge, or other disposition
20 of his property without a prior written order of the Court.
21 If during the pendency of this litigation, Defendant Clayton
22 should desire to sell, transfer, assign, pledge, or otherwise
23 dispose of any property, with a value in excess of Five
24 Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), he shall file a motion with the
25 Court, with written notice to the Plaintiffs, describing
26 with particularity the property, the terms and conditions of
27 the proposed disposition, the reasons for the proposed
28 disposition and the proposed provisions desired to insure
29 that the proceeds will be available, if necessary, to satisfy
30 any final judgment which may be rendered against him in this
31 case. After having provided all interested parties with an
32 opportunity to be heard on the proposed disposition, the

1 Court shall enter an order approving, disapproving or modifying
2 the proposed sale or transfer on such conditions as may
3 appear appropriate under all the circumstances. The net
4 proceeds otherwise due to Defendant Clayton from any such
5 disposition shall be placed in an interest-bearing escrow
6 account which shall be preserved during the pendency of this
7 litigation and shall be available to assist in satisfying
8 any resulting final judgment against Defendant Clayton.

9 3. Plaintiffs agree that they will not contest a
10 Deed of Trust which has been recorded in favor of Gregory
11 Corn, attorney for Defendant Clayton, and covering property
12 which is now owned by Clayton and was acquired by Clayton
13 prior to his employment by Amselco. This Deed of Trust is
14 recorded as Document No. 48848 in Book 49 of the Official
15 Records of White Pine County, Nevada, at pages 172 through
16 177.


17 4. Nothing in this Stipulation and Order shall
18 prevent Defendant Clayton from continuing the normal use and
19 enjoyment of his property, from making payments on pre-
20 existing debts or on pre-existing contractual obligations,
21 from making alimony or child support payments or from meeting
22 routine living expenses in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.00
23 per month; provided, however, that Defendant Clayton shall
24 take no action without prior Court approval which will
25 materially deplete, diminish or depreciate the value of the
26 property.

27 5. Plaintiffs, at their discretion, may file a
28 copy of this Stipulation and Order with interested persons
29 and with the appropriate authorities in any county in which
30 there is located any property of which Defendant Clayton is
31 the record or beneficial owner.


32 6. In connection with this Stipulation and Order,

6 otherwise.


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


