The work, development and improvements of the claims, performed between December 14, 1981 and February 3, 1982, on the Lamor Claim Group of 61 lode claims, located in the Southern Fish Creek Range, (unsurveyed Sec. 1, T17N, R52E; Sec. 1 and 12, T17N, R53E; Sec. 36, T18N, R53E, Eureka County, Nevada, consisted of:

- 1. 12000' of new roads were completed to 19 drill sites between Dec. 14-21, 1981. Claims affected by road work and site building were LM 1-3, 6-9, 12-13, 18, 56, 58, 60-61. A total of 43.5 hours of machine operating time were required, using a D-8 Cat with Parsons Construction Co., at a cost of \$4,785.00.
- Between December 17, 1981 and May 20, 1982, 19
 drill holes were completed on claims LM 1-3, 6-9,
 and 18, with a cumulative footage of 2990'. Total
 drilling costs were \$20,183.25 using a cyclone drill
 with Pollock Drilling Company of Ely, Nevada.
- 3. Between January 10 and February 3, 1982, additional cat work was required on the claim group to keep the roads open and accessible due to heavy snow. Total cost was \$4,169.00 using a D-7 cable dozer with Lee Construction, Elko, Nevada, with a total operating time of 53.5 hours.

Such work cost, and is valued at, in excess of \$29,000.00.

As a result of the above work, sufficient ore was detected. to justify additional testing and drilling of the type which normally precedes the development of a mine.

All of the aforesaid 67 unpatented lode mining claims are contiguous and work on any one claim or group of claims tends to develop all the claims. The work was performed for the purpose of developing the mineral potential of the claims, and to maintain and hold such claims.
