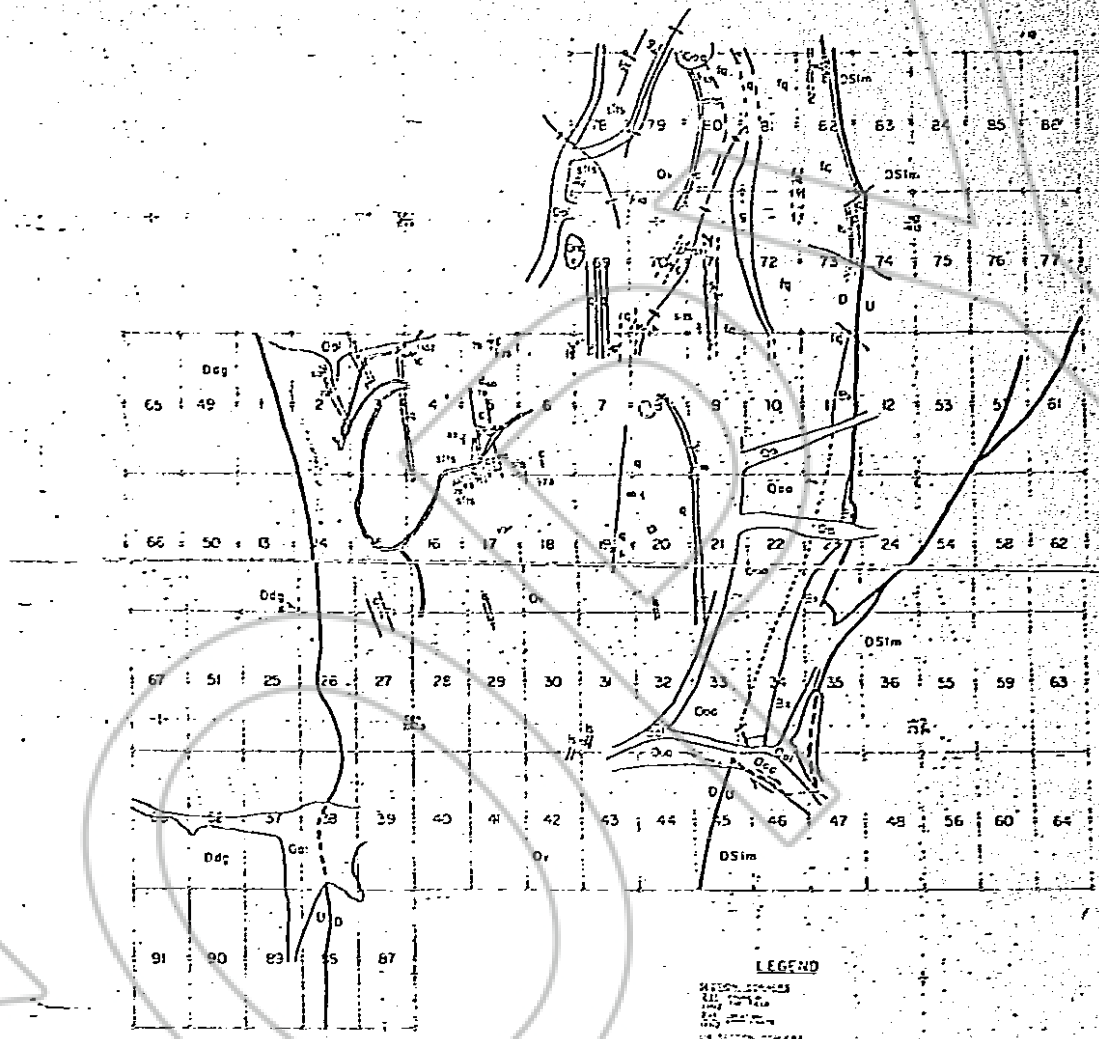

## SUMMARY REPORT

July 7, 1982

This detailed report and accompanying geologic map is filed in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code, Section 28-1 for the STAG #1-#91 (STAG #33-#36 and STAG #48 as amended) group of 91 lode mining claims situated in the Mineral Hill Mining District of Eureka County in the State of Nevada. The claim location notices and maps showing their geographic locations are recorded in the Eureka County records in Book 85, pages 328-413 and Book 86, pages 462-466 and/or as document numbers 75631-75724 and 76377-76382 and the amended locations in Book 87, pages 560-569 and/or as document numbers 76975-76979. They are recorded in the BLM records in Reno, Nevada under Serial No. NMC 163380 through NMC 163465 and Serial No. NMC 167191 through NMC 167195. This report and the accompanying geologic map are the result of a portion of the assessment work for the assessment year ended September 1, 1982 on the aforementioned claims.

The work consisted of both reconnaissance and detailed geologic mapping of the entire claim group to further evaluate the discovery of valuable mineral deposits located thereon and to assist in planning further exploration and development work. The work was performed between May 22, 1982 and July 7, 1982 by William D. Collins of 20802 Pleasant Park Rd., Conifer, Colorado 80433, the locator/owner of the claims and a geologist of 27 years experience with a degree from the University of Idaho (B.S. Geol. Engr., 1955) and a holder of Colorado Professional Engineer Certificate No. 10117 and California Professional Geologist Certificate No. 703. The cost and/or value of the geologic mapping and associated work exceeded \$9100.00 and was borne by William D. Collins, the locator/owner of the STAG lode claim group.

The results of the geologic mapping are shown on the accompanying geologic map entitled "Partial Geologic Map, STAG Lode Claim Group" updated on July 7, 1982. In as far as the mapping extended, it showed structural and rock type features which correlated with known mineral occurrences and geochemical anomalies. When completed, the geologic mapping and further exploration work will be coordinated to guide exploration and development drilling for further evaluation of the claim group.
