The following was performed as the annual assessment work:

- A. Detailed geologic mapping and analysis.
- B. Rock chip sampling.
- C. Chemical analysis of rock chip samples for Ag, Au, As, and Sb.

The above work was performed on the claims as depicted on the map attached hereto and made a part hereof but affects all of the above claims, such claims being contiguous. The work was commenced on July 13, 1982 and was concluded on July 28, 1982. The total amount spent for the work was \$2,246.49.

The geological and chemical analysis, evaluation and interpretation of the basic data collected during this work reveals that significant gold, silver, arsenic and antimony anomalies occur in Tertiary volcanic and Paleozoic sedimentary rocks. Such mineralization as defined by the geochemical anomalies justifies more extensive development work on each and every one of the aforementioned claims.

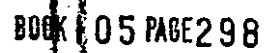

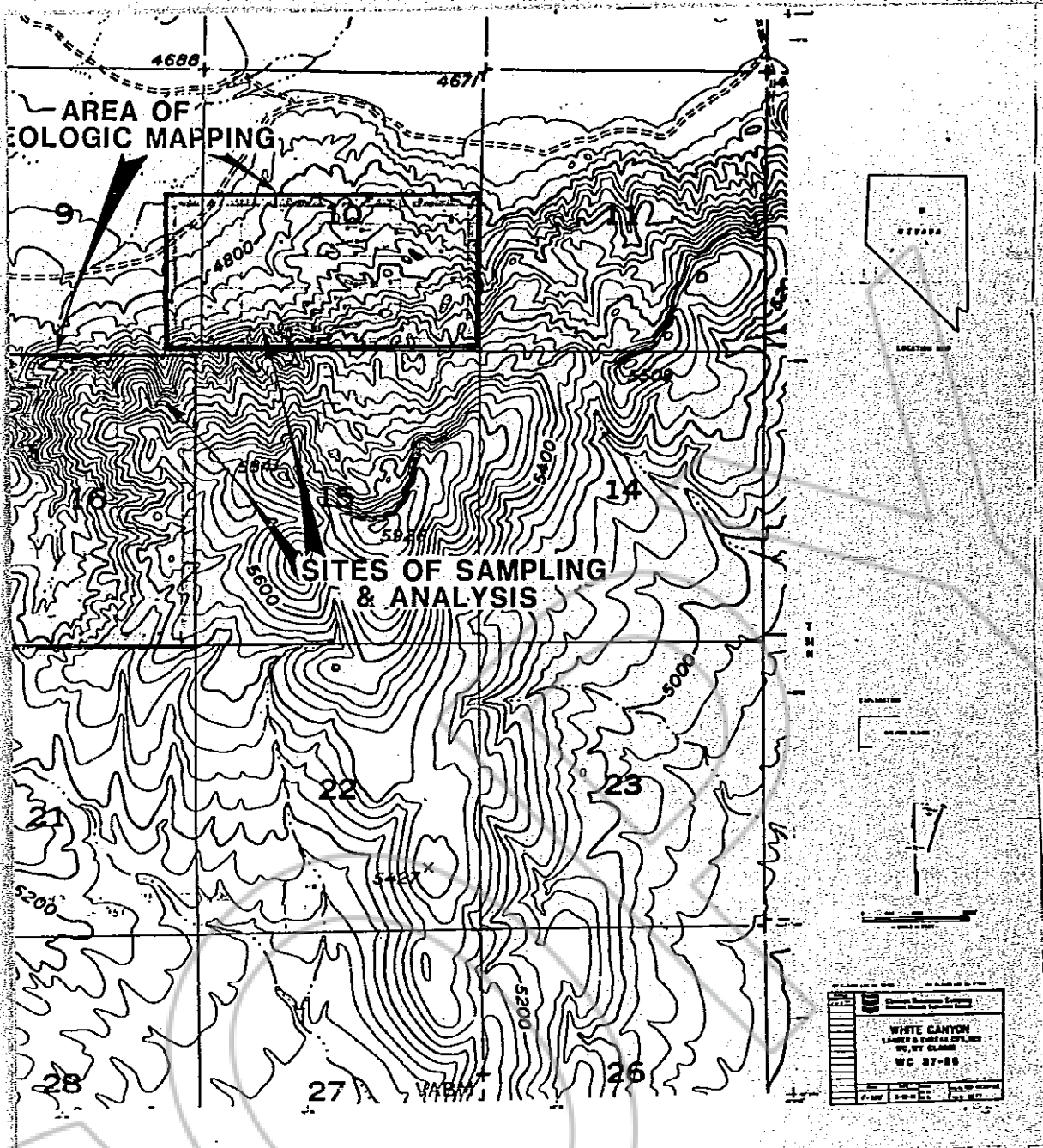
