SUMMARY REPORT

This report is filed in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code, Section 28-1 for MC#34 - MC#36 Nos. A contiguous group of 3 claims situated in the Maggie Creek mining district of Eureka County, State of Nevada.

The work consisted of detailed geologic studies and geochemical investigations of the entire claim group to facilitate future exploration and development efforts. The work was performed July 9 - August 3, 1982 by or under the direct supervision of James A. Woods of South 4814 Bowdish Low Court, Spokane, Washington, a geologist with 14 years experience in exploration and production geology with a degree from the University of Colorado (B.A., 1971). The cost of the geologic-geochemical study exceeded \$300.00 and was paid for by Western States Minerals Corporation.

The geologic work relied on both detailed mapping of geologic structures and alteration patterns within the claim group. Both mapping efforts were large scale and detailed (1" = 100').

The geochemical effort was also of two types:


- 1.) Soil sampling covering the entire claim area utilizing a 100 yard grid. All soil samples were sent to Monitor Geochemical Laboratories in Elko, Nevada, for a multi-element determination. The sample locations were then plotted on a base map with their assay values. A contour map was then constructed from this data.
- 2.) Rock chipping and channel sampling of favorable rock type and alteration locales was accomplished. All above samples were submitted to the Western States Minerals Corporation Laboratory for both atomic absorption and fire assay determinations. All results were plotted on a base map to note trends related to structure, favorable rock types, or alteration patterns.

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The combined geologic and geochemical results indicate anomalous concentrations of various metals. These anomalous zones may be further tested with an ongoing geophysical and geologic program, culminating in drilling certain of the most promising targets.
