

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION - NEVADA

THE UNDERSIGNED, hereby certifies that EXXON CORPORATION, by its Agent, the undersigned, does hereby locate the CC 35 Lode Mining Claim on this 14 day of November, 19 82, situated in the Unknown Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada.

Said Claim is located in the NE 1/4 (Quarter) Section(s) 3-2, Township 22 North, Range 50 East, Mt. Diablo P.M., and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the northeast corner post No. 1,

- Thence, 600 feet in a Southerly direction to Post No. 2,
- Thence, 750 feet in a Westerly direction to Post No. 3,
- Thence, 750 feet in a Westerly direction to Post No. 4,
- Thence, 600 feet in a Northerly direction to Post No. 5,
- Thence, 750 feet in a Easterly direction to Post No. 6,
- Thence, 750 feet in a Easterly direction to Post No. 1,

the point of beginning and all posts being 4" x 4" x 5'.
