SUMMARY REPORT

This detailed report is filed in compliance with the requirements of Title 30 U.S.C. 28-1 for those claims shown by Exhibit "A".

The work consisted of a rock chip sampling program, geologic mapping and related activities during the month of August, 1983. The work was done to further evaluate the potential for valuable mineral deposits and assist in further exploration and development work.

The work was performed by Gary L. Grauberger, a geologist with twelve years experience in exploration with a degree from the University of Colorado, David J. May, a geologist with seven years experience in exploration with a degree from the University of Texas (Austin) and Robert F. Hemming, a geologist with seven years experience with a degree from Colorado State University.
