- 2. There was expended for said labor and improvements or the value thereof an amount in excess of One Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$1,100.00).
- 3. The said labor and improvement consisted of a geological survey upon and within the boundaries of the claim group shown on Attachment No. 1. The survey was performed by and under the direction of M. C. Godbe, III, 1012 Newhouse Building, Salt Lake City, Utah, Consulting Geologist, holding degrees from the University of Utah and having more than 30 years experience in the fields of geology and geoscience.

The nature and extent of the work included detailed examination of data obtained from work on the ground in the entire area contained within the outside boundaries of the claims and corelation to geological features in the general area of the claims.

The basic findings resulting from the survey are that:

(a) The subject claims are located on the northeast flank of the Lynn Window, a regional erosional feature which exposes rocks below the Roberts Mountain Thrust and is relative to the position of the Carlin Gold Mine located on the northeast edge of the said Lynn Window.

- (b) Bedrock exposures on the subject properties comprise black to grey carbonaceous shales of middle Ordovician age commonly referred to as "siliceous western assemblage" rocks.
- (c) The "carbonate eastern assemblage" rocks consisting of limestone and dolomite, are known to occur in outcrop as upthrown fault blocks on the northeast flank of the Lynn Window. "Carbonate eastern assemblage" rocks are expected to occur in the subsurface of the subject claims, with the depth to these rocks yet to be determined. Based upon recent drill holes, depth of "carbonate eastern assemblage" rocks is greater than 250 feet below the surface.
- (d) Productive gold mineralization occurs in eastern and western assemblage rocks and similar mineralization occurs in outcroping western assemblage rocks and drill hole intercepts on the subject claims.
- The above named and described unpatented lode mining claims comprise a contiguous group of lode mining claims owned in common by Charleen F. Mee. The said labor was performed and improvements made for the benefit of each and all of said mining claims comprising said contiguous group, as a part of a general plan of development and they tend to improve and develop each and all of said mining claims. The amount expended for and value of said labor and improvements is not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each of the mining claims comprising said contiguous group. The said expenditure was made in good faith for the purpose of developing said contiguous group of mining claims and was intended as annual labor and improvements for each and all of the above described unpatented lode mining claims.
