Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person hable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any inferest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition increto) shall be a ben in layor of the tituled States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belongi
