1 This judgment constitutes an amendment of the judgment 2 signed by the Honorable John Dearman on Feb / , 1984. These causes came on regularly for trial on January 11, 1984, 3 in Department 20 of the above-entitled Court, the Honorable John 4 Dearman, Judge, presiding. Plaintiff appeared by his attorney 5 John Mahoney, defendant and cross-complainant Bruce A. Seymour 7 appeared by his attorney Dan W. Lacy, defendant Safeco Title Insurance Co. appeared by its attorney John B. Dickson, and 8 defendants City and County of San Francisco and Thomas Kearney 9 appeared by City Attorney George Agnost, through Deputy City 10 11 Attorney Phyllis Walker. 12 A jury of twelve persons was regularly impaneled and sworn 13 to try the actions. Witnesses on the part of plaintiff and all 14 defendants were sworn and examined. After hearing the evidence, 15 the arguments of counsel, and instructions of the Court, the jury 16 retired to consider its verdict and subsequently returned to Court; 17 being called, the jurors answered to their names and duly rendered 18 their verdict in writing, in words and figures as follows: 19 We, the jury in the above-entitled actions, find for the 20 plaintiff and against the defendants and assess damages as follows: 21 Compensatory Damages \$200.000.00 22 Punitive Damages (against defendant Seymour only) \$2,660,000.00 23 24
