CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION - NEVADA

THE UNDERSIGNED, hereby certifies that ATLAS CORPORATION, by its Agent, the undersigned, does hereby locate the JASPER 560 Lode Mining Claim on this 11th day of June, 1984, situated in the UNKNOWN Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada.

Said Claim is located in the NE (Quarter) Section(s) 34 Township 22 N., Range 50 E., Mt. Diablo P.M., and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the northeast corner post No. 1,

Thence, <u>750</u> feet in a <u>SOUTH</u> direction to Post No. 2,
Thence, <u>750</u> feet in a <u>SOUTH</u> direction to Post No. 3,

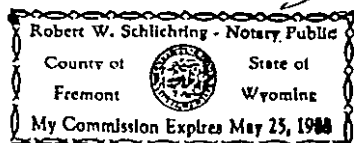
