## CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION - NEVADA

THE UNDERSIGNED, hereby certifies that ATLAS CORPORATION, by its Agent, the undersigned, does hereby locate the JASPER 782 Lode Mining Claim on this 16th day of June, 1984, situated in the UNKNOWN Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada.

Said Claim is located in the SE (NE) (Quarter) Section(s) 17 (20) Township 22 N., Range 50 E., Mt. Diablo P.M., and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the northeast corner post No. 1,

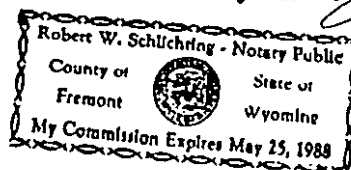
