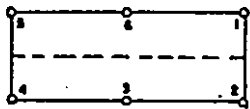

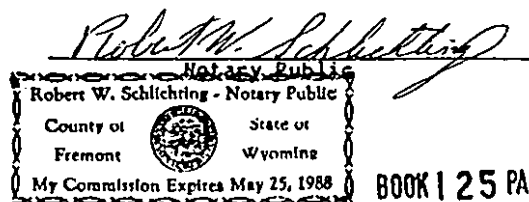
Beginning at the northeast corner post No. 1,
