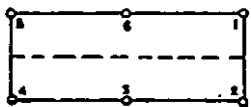

## CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION - NEVADA

THE UNDERSIGNED, hereby certifies that ATLAS CORPORATION, by its Agent, the under-  
signed, does hereby locate the JASPER 1633 Lode Mining Claim on this  
2nd day of July, 1984, situated in the UNKNOWN Mining  
District, Eureka County, Nevada.

Said Claim is located in the NW (Quarter) Section(s) 34,  
Township 22 N., Range 49 E., Mt. Diablo P.M., and more particularly  
described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the northeast corner post No. 1,

Thence, <u>750</u> feet in a <u>SOUTH</u> direction to Post No. 2,
Thence, <u>750</u> feet in a <u>SOUTH</u> direction to Post No. 3,
Thence, <u>300</u> feet in a <u>WEST</u> direction to Post No. 4,
Thence, <u>750</u> feet in a <u>NORTH</u> direction to Post No. 5,
Thence, <u>750</u> feet in a <u>NORTH</u> direction to Post No. 6,
Thence, <u>300</u> feet in a <u>EAST</u> direction to Post No. 1,

the point of beginning and all posts being 4" x 5'.

The claim monument on which the Notice is posted lies approximately midway between  
the two sides and is 10 feet from the NORTH end and 1490 feet  
from the SOUTH end.

To tie this Claim to the Public Survey, begin at the SOUTHEAST corner,  
Section 24, Township 22 N., Range 49 E., Mt. Diablo P.M., bear  
SOUTH, 6193 feet, and EAST, 17741 feet to the northeast corner of this Claim.

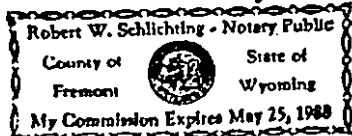
