CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION - NEVADA

THE UNDERSIGNED, hereby certifies that ATLAS CORPORATION, by its Agent, the undersigned, does hereby locate the JASPER 1128 Lode Mining Claim on this 24th day of June, 1984, situated in the UNKNOWN Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada.

Said Claim is located in the SE (NE) (Quarter) Section(s) 26 (26), Township 23 N., Range 49 E., Mt. Diablo P.M., and more particularly, described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the northeast corner post No. 1,

Thence, <u>750</u> feet in a <u>SOUTH</u> direction to Post No. 2,
Thence, <u>750</u> feet in a <u>SOUTH</u> direction to Post No. 3,
Thence, <u>600</u> feet in a <u>WEST</u> direction to Post No. 4,
Thence, <u>750</u> feet in a <u>NORTH</u> direction to Post No. 5,
Thence, <u>750</u> feet in a <u>NORTH</u> direction to Post No. 6,
Thence, <u>600</u> feet in a <u>EAST</u> direction to Post No. 1,

the point of beginning and all posts being 4" x 5'.



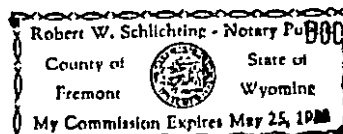
