WHEREAS, EOR Petroleum Company, a Colorado corporation, has granted a security interest to First Colorado Bank and Trust, N.A., formerly University National Bank, as to any and all contract rights of EOR Petroleum Company under that agreement entitled "Exploration Agreement" dated June 20, 1980, as amended by Agreement dated June 30, 1983, made and entered into between J. Ellerton Consultants, Inc., 1624 Market Street, Suite 209, Denver, Colorado 80202, all of its right, title, interest and security under those Financing Statements described above insofar as the same may affect the interest of Com-Tek Resources, Inc., successor in interest to J. Ellerton Consultants, Inc.

This Release is executed for the purpose of discharging and relinquishing the interest of the Bank in the real and personal property affected by said Financing Statements insofar as said Financing Statements may affect the interest of Com-Tek Resources, Inc. and shall not be construed to discharge any of the responsibilities or liabilities of EOR Petroleum Company to the Bank by virtue of its security interest as evidenced by said Financing Statements.

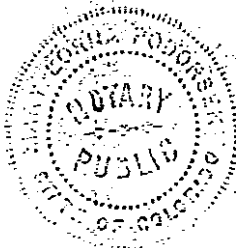
