- (12) Neither the property nor any portion thereof or interest therein shall be leased, assigned, sold, transferred or encumbered, voluntarily or otherwise, without the written consent of the Government. The Government shall have the sole and exclusive rights as beneficiary hereunder, including but not limited to the power to grant consents, partial releases, subordinations, and satisfaction, and no insured holder shall have any right, title or interest in or to the lien of any benefits hereof.
- (13) At all reasonable times the Government and its agents may inspect the property to ascertain whether the coverants and agreements contained herein or in any supplementary agreement are being performed.
- (14) The Government may (a) extend or defer the majurity of, and renew and reschedule the payments on, the debt evidenced by the note or any indebtedness to the Government secured by this instrument, (b) release any party who is liable under the note or for the debt from liability to the Government, (c) release portions of the property and subordinate its lien, and (d) waive any other of its rights under this instrument. - (17) SHOULD DEFAULT occur in the performance or discharge of any obligation in this isntrument or secured by this instrument, or should the parties named as Borrower die or be declared incompetent, or should any one of the parties named as Borrower be declared a bunkrupt or an insolvent, or make an assignment for the benefit of creditors, the Government, at its option with or without notice, may: (a) declare the entire amount unpaid under the note and any indebtedness to the Government hereby secured immediately due and payable, (b) for the account of Borrower incur and pay reasonable expenses for repair or maintenance of and take possession of, operate or tent the property, (c) upon application by it and production of this instrument, without other evidence and without notice of hearing of said application, have a receiver appointed for the property, with the usual powers of receivers in like cases, and (d) authorize and request Trustee to foreclose this instrument and sell the property as provided by law, (e) bring an action to foreclose this instrument, obtain a deficiency judgment, or enforce any other remedy provided by law.
