

JOINT DECLARATION OF HOMESTEAD

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, HAROLD LEMLER and DENISE R. LEMLER, hereby declare:

That we are husband and wife respectively. The husband, HAROLD LEMLER, is the head of the family. Said family consists of said husband and wife.

County of Eureka, State of Nevada.


That we estimate the actual value of said premises to be SEVENTY FIVE THOUSAND (\$75,000.00) DOLLARS.

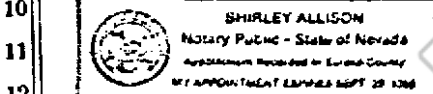
