

## Summary Report

This detailed report is filed in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code, Section 28-1 for the CM 1-27 and TS 150-158, a contiguous group of 36 lode mining claims situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

The work consisted of a geophysical survey to evaluate the discovery of gold mineralization within the claim group and to assist in planning further exploration and development work.
