## Summary Report

This detailed report is filed in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code, Section 28-1 for the GK 1-32, a contiguous group of 32 lode mining claims situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

The work consisted of a geophysical survey to evaluate the discovery of gold mineralization within the claim group and to assist in planning further exploration and development work. The work was performed during the period August 20, 1985 to August 30, 1985 under the direct supervision of Gale Knutsen of 325 Skyline Dr., Elko, Nevada and Robert Craig of 234 West Ash St., Elko, NV., professional geologists employed by Newmont Exploration Limited, 1100 Lamoille Highway, Elko, Nevada. Mr. Knutsen has a Master's Degree in Geology from Washington State University, Pullman, Washington and has been a practicing geologist for over 6 years.
