This report is filed in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code, Section 28-1, for the following forty-seven (47) contiguous lode mining claims located in Sections 1, 12, 12, and 24; T22N; R50E; and Sections 18 and 19; T22N; R50E; in the Unknown Mining District; Eureka County; State of Nevada:

The cost of this work exceeded \$4,700 and consisted of road and drill pad construction, rotary drilling, and geochemical analysis of soil and rock chip samples, and of drill cuttings. Soil and rock chip sampling was undertaken between August 7 and August 10, 1985 on Essex No.'s 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 24, and 25; drilling and rolated roadwork was done between August 27 and August 31, 1985 on Essex No.'s 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14.

Geochemical sampling and supervision of a portion of the drilling was performed by Joseph F. Leising; a geologist of 15 years experience with a geology A.B. degree from the University of California, Santa Cruz, California. The road construction and a portion of the drilling was supervised by David A. Saegart; a mining engineer of 7 years experience whose degree was taken at the Colorado School of Mines. The overall supervision was done by Francis E. Du Bois, III; a geological engineer of 35 years experience and president of Alhambra Mines, Inc. The drilling was performed by Cooper & Sons Construction, 925 Park Avenue, Ely, Nevada. The geochemical analyses were performed by Chemex Labs, 155 Glendale, Sparks, Nevada.

The basic findings of the study are that anomalous gold and mercury mineralization in the area may indicate significant precious metals mineralization in unexposed lithologically favorable sediments.
