Beginning at Corner No. 1, the Northeast corner, which is located 1500 feet South and 3900 feet East from the NE corner of Section 4, Township 25 North, Range 48 East, Mount Diablo Meridian; thence,

- South 750' to the East side center, a 4" x 4" x 4 1/2' wood post; thence, South 750' to the SE corner, a 4" x 4" x 4 1/2' wood post; thence, West 600' to the SW corner, a 4" x 4" x 4 1/2' wood post; thence, North 750' to the West side center, a 4" x 4" x 4 1/2' wood post; thence, North 750' to the NW corner, a 4" x 4" x 4 1/2' wood post; thence, East 600' to the NE corner, a 4" x 4" x 4 1/2' wood post; the

We (or I) claim 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 10 feet from the location monument in a Northerly direction, and 1490 feet in a Southerly direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The monumentation and marking of the corners was completed by the 29th day of September, 1985.
