

## CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION - NEVADA

THE UNDERSIGNED, hereby certifies that ATLAS PRECIOUS METALS, INC., by its Agent, the undersigned, does hereby locate the W<sup>1</sup> 238 Lode Mining Claim on this 19th day of July, 1986, situated in the Unknown Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada.

Said Claim is located in the SE(SW)(NE)(NW) (Quarter) Section(s) 23(23)(26)(26), Township 22 N., Range 50 E., Mt. Diablo P.M., and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the northeast corner post No. 1,

Thence, 600 feet in a South direction to Post No. 2,  
Thence, 750 feet in a West direction to Post No. 3,  
Thence, 750 feet in a West direction to Post No. 4,  
Thence, 600 feet in a North direction to Post No. 5,  
Thence, 750 feet in a East direction to Post No. 2,

the point of beginning and all posts being 4" X 4" plastic pipe.

The claim monument on which the Notice is posted lies approximately midway between the two sides and is 10 feet from the east end and 1490 feet from the west end. The general course of the Lode as near as may be is east and west.
