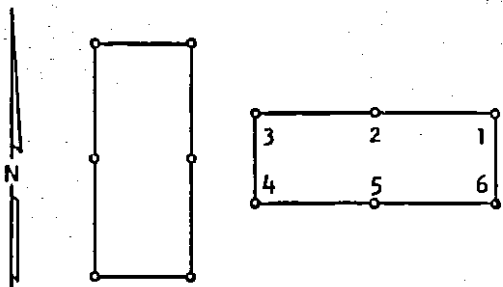

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION - NEVADA

THE UNDERSIGNED, hereby certifies that ATLAS PRECIOUS METALS, INC., by its Agent, the undersigned, does hereby locate the GLEN 7 Lode Mining Claim on this 15th day of July, 1986, situated in the Unknown Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada.

Said Claim is located in the SE(SW)(NE)(NW) (Quarter) Section(s) 28(27)(33)(34), Township 23 N., Range 51 E., Mt. Diablo P.M., and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the northeast corner post No. 1,

- Thence, 750 feet in a west direction to Post No. 2,
- Thence, 750 feet in a west direction to Post No. 3,
- Thence, 600 feet in a south direction to Post No. 4,
- Thence, 750 feet in a east direction to Post No. 5,
- Thence, 750 feet in a east direction to Post No. 6,
- Thence, 600 feet in a north direction to Post No. 1,

the point of beginning and all posts being 4" X 4" plastic pipe.

The claim monument on which the Notice is posted lies approximately midway between the two sides and is 10 feet from the east end and 1490 feet from the west end. The general course of the Lode as near as may be is east and west.

To tie this Claim to the Public Survey, begin at the south 1/4 corner, Section 34, Township 23 N., Range 51 E., Mt. Diablo P.M., bear north, 5820 feet, and west, 1885 feet to the northeast corner of this Claim.
