This detailed report is filed in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code, Section 28-1, for the Orion 109 through Orion 126, a contiguous group of 18 lode mining claims situated in the Beowawe Mining District, Eureka County, Nevada.

The work consisted of collecting 120 geochemical samples, making geological observations, and having the samples analyzed. The work was performed to help determine future drill sites. The work was performed under a contract with Bristlecone, Inc. between August 11 and August 15, 1987 by George J. Lindenburg of 1620 College Parkway #11, Elko, Nevada 89801, a geologist with over 25 years of experience with an M.S. degree in geology from the University of Utah. The survey and analyses cost over \$1800.00 and were paid for by Bristlecone, Inc. for the benefit of the claims under a Joint Venture Agreement with Orion Minerals, owner of the claims.

The geochemical samples were collected on a grid pattern with a spacing of 300 feet north and south and 500 feet east and west. The pattern extended over all of the claims. The samples were analyzed for gold, silver, arsenic, mercury, and antimony. Anomalous values were discovered.
