Report on Geochemical Survey for Claims
RC 1, RC 2, RC 3, RC 4

A geochemical survey of the above listed unpatented mining claims was conducted in August of 1987. Rock chip samples were taken from RC 3 encompassing an area of 500 feet by 1400 feet. Samples were taken on 100 foot interval along north-south traverses 200 feet apart. Samples were assayed for silver and gold by Chemex Labs Ltd. in Vancouver, B.C.

The results of the survey show a small localized anomalous area of Gold in:

- the northwest corner of RC 3

The small localized anomalous areas of Silver were in:

- along the western side of RC 3
- the west central portion of RC 3

This survey was non-repetitive of any previously known work, and did benefit the exploration and development of each claim in this group.

The work was carried out by Anne E. Pate, a qualified expert in the field of mining and exploration for 11 years.
